These records are not complete but are an excellent source of information as to old records.</p>

The library also has some census records for Miami and Champaign Counties (and other surrounding countries). Or write to US Dept.</p>
<p>LINEAGE BOOKS (DAC & DAR BOOKS ALSO)</p>	<p>The Library has Mayflower Book, etc., giving names of passengers on Mayflower and naming ancestors through the Revolution.</p>
<p>CITY AND COUNTY DIRECTORIES</p>	<p>The library has all city directories and some rural directories.</p>
<p>NEWSPAPERS</p>	<p>The library has all evening papers since 1910.</p>
